What is Kindergruppe Kinderladen Hütteldorf?

Our Kindergarten was founded by parents and kindergarten teachers for the collective supervision of children aged 2 to 6 with shared goals and contents. Such a kindergarten is called a "Kindergruppe".

The kindergarten is situated in the west of Vienna, in Penzing, a district with a large portion of greenery including a part of the Vienna Woods.

It is managed by the parents. In our parental managed "Kindergruppe" two caregivers care for 13 children from 2 to 6 years old. In our everyday work we value most of all respect, room for individual development and a feeling of security. We let ourselves be guided by the needs of our children and decide with them our daily activities.

Proposed activities

As a volunteer, we would like you to be present about 30 hours per week. The opening hours of the kindergarten are Monday to Friday 8:00-16:00. You will have your lunch with the children. Additionally, there are regular planning meetings with the parents and the teachers. You will be integrated in the daily schedule of the Kindergruppe (Kindergarten) and will support our team of pedagogues. This includes welcoming the children, helping them with their clothing, participating in the morning plans, such as playing music, doing handicraft, drawing, cooking and baking, going outside to nature, as well as observing and supporting the children in their doing and needs.

Themes: Many activities are also organised according to themes and seasons: Christmas, Easter, Autumn etc.

Events: Then there are small events like for example the Summer Party – this is a common activity of all parents and children. It's a saying "good bye" to the past kindergarten year.

As a volunteer, we welcome you to give input to all our activities for example to prepare a special project week on your country

Volunteers are invited to join this colourful group of children, teachers and parents at learning, growing and experiencing.

Volunteer profile and recruitment process

We are looking for a person who really likes to work with children and our teachers. It would be nice if you are creative and willing to bring in your ideas. It would be of advantage if you have basic knowledge of English (or German) to be able to communicate with the team.

The ESC/EVS in Vienna is coordinated by Grenzenlos within the MELANGE program. If you are interested, you just send a CV (curriculum vitae), a motivation letter and the full details of the responsible sending organisation to Grenzenlos. They will forward your papers to the hosting project (Kindergruppe Butterbrot) where the selection will be made.

All available placements of Grenzenlos ESC/EVS projects are open to everyone (fulfilling the general EVS criteria). However, in the selection procedure a preference is shown for candidates with fewer opportunities (gender, background etc.).
